This two-day painting workshop will explore the watercolor medium and the visual splendors of the spring season. A seasonal arrangement of spring flowers and plants, colorful fruits and vegetables, and a variety of decorative objects will be presented for painting exploration and experimentation. Students will begin by doing preliminary drawing and painting studies in their sketchbooks before developing larger paintings using a variety of watercolor methods and approaches. Composition, color and painting processes will be discussed. A healthy lunch will be provided on both days.
